

This policy is ROA's Acceptable Use Policy for the Learning Management System (LMS) and related digital tools and resources.

Educational Use Only

The LMS and all related tools and resources are to be used strictly for educational purposes. Any use outside of this scope is considered inappropriate, including but not limited to criminal activity, obscene content, commercial purposes, or other illegal activity.

Review and Consequences

The administration reserves the right to review student work to determine the appropriateness of computer use. If the LMS is used inappropriately, the administration will impose consequences, which may include suspension or removal from the program. In severe cases, further action may be taken, including contacting a student's day school, legal representation, or the police.

Digital Safety and Responsible Citizenship

- Protect personal information and the privacy of others.
- Report suspicious, harmful, or inappropriate online activity to school authorities.
- Use digital tools and platforms responsibly, ensuring interactions remain respectful and constructive.

Student Vigilance

- Always protect passwords and never share them with anyone.
- Always inform teachers of suspicious messages or other concerning incidents.
- Always access only content intended for student use.

Implementation

The Principal and staff of Royal Ontario Academy are responsible for implementing and enforcing this policy. All members of the school community are expected to adhere to it to maintain a positive and secure virtual learning environment.

This policy is reviewed periodically to ensure clarity, fairness, and alignment with Ontario Ministry of Education requirements and ROA operational needs, and is updated as needed.
