This Code of Conduct outlines the expectations for student behaviour, digital citizenship, and academic integrity, and serves as a guide for a positive and secure virtual learning space.

Commitment to Respect and Safety

Respect, courtesy, and responsible behaviour are fundamental values at ROA. All students are expected to treat others with kindness and consideration, fostering an atmosphere where everyone can learn and grow without fear of harm or discrimination.

Zero-Tolerance Policy on Bullying, Harassment, and Discrimination

The Academy maintains a zero-tolerance stance on bullying, harassment, discrimination, or any actions that compromise the safety or well-being of others. Such behaviours are promptly addressed by the Principal, with consequences that may include:

- Counselling and support interventions
- Parental involvement
- Suspension or expulsion from the Academy
- Involvement of law enforcement or other authorities, when warranted

Upholding Academic Integrity

Students are expected to demonstrate honesty and integrity in their academic work. Academic misconduct is addressed under the Cheating and Plagiarism Policy, with consequences aimed at reinforcing ethical standards.

Appropriate Computer Use

Students must adhere to the Appropriate Computer Use Policy to ensure that the Learning Management System (LMS) and other digital resources are used solely for educational purposes. Misuse of technology, including engaging in illegal activities, cyberbullying, or accessing inappropriate content, is strictly prohibited.

Digital Safety and Responsible Citizenship

- Protect personal information and the privacy of others.
- Report suspicious, harmful, or inappropriate online activity to school authorities.
- Use digital tools and platforms responsibly, ensuring interactions remain respectful and constructive.

Adherence to this Code of Conduct is essential for the safety, success, and well-being of all students at Royal Ontario Academy.

This policy is reviewed periodically to ensure clarity, fairness, and alignment with Ontario Ministry of Education requirements and ROA operational needs, and is updated as needed. Final decisions on interpretation and application rest
